5. Tournament general info

Sports bags are not allowed on the stand. There will be a free manned cloakroom where you can deliver your sport bags.

Time scheduled and draws will be out on www.sportdata.org as soon as possible after the end of registration.

We reserve the right to merge categories when there are too few competitors in the categories.

Changing a competitor during the registration in another category is allowed. In this case you must pay the double entry fee (Details see section 'Entry payment')

No double starts allowed according to the rules for the Nordic Karate Federation only U21 and Seniors in kumite, Junior and Senior in kata

The coach must show a valid ID for every competitor (passport or ID of national federation) to verify her/his identity and age, and a copy of the blanket" Parents contents" see details under section 8.1.

The organizer can exclude athletes, coaches and accompanying persons from the hall, if they do not follow the instruction of the security service. Persons who act in a threatening and/or violent against referees or athletes they can be excluded as well from the tournament.

Age limit appointed date is 23rd February 2024.

Max. limit in kata pools are 24 participants, when max. participants is reach then the pool is closed for registrations.

All entries on Sportdata.org starts on a waiting list until payment is received.

6. Protest

Any protest concerning application of the rules must be announced by the Coach no later than one minute after the end of the bout. The Coach will request the official protest form from the Tatami Manager and will have four minutes to have it completed, signed, and submitted to Tatami Manager with the corresponding fee. A protest fee of 200 €/1500 Dkr. must be paid before the protest is handled to the Tatami Manager. The Tatami Manager will immediately hand the completed protest form to a representative of the Appeals Jury that will have five minutes to render a decision. Should the protest be approved, the fee will be refunded.

7. Photographer

Photographers need an official authorization from the organizer (for the tatami area). They should not disturb the course of the tournament. Authorization can be given for a fee of 500 Danish kr.

8. Condition for participation

Coach is responsible for medical certificates and parents contents.

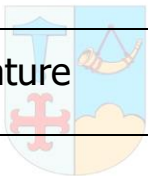

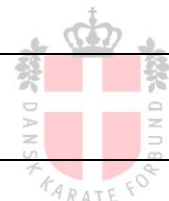

9. Coach

The registration of coaches should be done online on Sportdata.org. Each 5 competitor is issued a coach card. Additional cards are available for a fee of 50,- Dkr pr. card. Max. 6 coach a team. Only companions with a valid and official coach-card are allowed to enter the hall. All other companions and spectators may only be at the grandstand and must not enter the hall (tatami area). The coach-card will be given at the coach meeting Friday 23rd February 2024. Only coaches registered via sportdata.org get a coach-card. If the coaches aren't registered by 9th February 2024, they must pay a fee of 50,- Dkr. pr. card at the registration until the maximum number of coaches is reached. Coaches should be dress in sport dress with club emblem.

In the Kata finals, Kumite finals and Grand Champions Cup male coaches are required to wear a dark suit, shirt and tie, while female coaches may choose to wear a dress, pantsuit or a combination of jacket and skirt in dark colors. Female coaches may wear WKF approved religiously mandated headwear for referees and judges.

10. Award ceremony

Awards to 1st, 2nd and the 2 3rd places. At the award ceremony the competitor should dress a karate-Gi or a sport dress. Award ceremony at the end of the tournament day.

11. Spectator entrance fee

12. Entry payment

350,- Dkr. Per. Individual

700,- Dkr. Per. Team

All entries on Sportdata.org starts on a waiting list until payment is received.

Registration will be via www.sportdata.org until 9th of February 2024.

Registration after this date is on a limited basis and at the sole discretion of the Tournament Director. A late fee of 350 Dkr. / 50€ will be added to the fees detailed above. Changing a competitor during the registration in another category is only allowed on Thursday 22nd and Friday 23rd February 2024. In this case, you must pay 2 x entry fee.

Registration obligates payment.

Bandages need to be approved from the referee committee.

- Official red and blue fist protection
- Official red and blue foot protection
- Official red and blue shin guard
- Dental protection
- Chest protector for female U14, Cadet, Junior, U21, and Senior participants.
- Body protection for all athletes.

Not allowed

- Face mask
- Embroidered on belts / Gi

14. Modus Kumite / Kata

Kumite 10 Years, 11 Years and U14 will be arranged depending by weight.

Match time U14 1,5 min and 10 + 11 years 1 min.

Kumite Cadets, Junior, Senior and U21 WKF / DkarF rules.

Team kumite categories follows the WKF / DkarF rules for kumite. It is allowed to build a team existing of competitors from different dojos from different country. Each competitor can only be on 1 team. No repechage in team & open.

By car

From the highway from the south, take exit "6 Ishøj", and take a right turn to "Ishøj stationsvej". Straight ahead for about 3 km, after the 2nd round about there is a crossing. Take a left turn by the Q8 service station to "Vejlebrovej". Take a right turn in next crossing to "Vejledalen" and then follow the signs to the arena.

From the highway from the north, take exit "26 Ishøj strand", and take a left turn to "Ishøj stationsvej". Straight ahead for about 1,5 km, after the 2nd round about there is a crossing. Take a left turn by the Q8 service station to "Vejlebrovej". Take a right turn in next crossing to "Vejledalen" and then follow the signs to the arena.
